I am delighted to announce that we have begun rehearsals for our presentation of *Alice in Wonderland*. The stage rehearsals will be June 20 and 21 from approximately 4:00-8:00 p.m. We will perform on Saturday, June 22 at 2:00 p.m. at the beautiful, state-of-the-art Joan B. Kroc Theatre on University Avenue. It has a beautiful house which seats 500 people, as well as, all the theatrical capabilities to enable us to create a spectacular performance. The theatre has several beautiful, large dressing rooms and closed-circuit televisions in the dressing rooms so that those who are kind enough to volunteer and the dancers who are waiting to perform will be able to see what is happening on stage.

Because of the short time frame we have to mount this production, I ask that you read the attached information carefully and complete the attached form **NO LATER THAN SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 16**. I will need to know how many dancers plan to participate in order to make, alter, and purchase the costumes in time for our performance. Each family will pay an all-inclusive Performance Fee of \$210. This includes the cost of costume rental, the Post-Concert Gathering, and entitles each family to two free tickets. Any extra tickets can be purchased for \$30 for adults and \$25 for children.

Volunteers

As always, the success of our production is contingent upon the participation of our dancers' families. I hope many of you will be willing to make this the best experience for our children as possible. Please let me know if you are able to help!

Costume Mother. Each dance will need someone to take the costumes from the studio and transport them to the theatre during the first Stage Rehearsal, then return the costumes back to the studio after the performance. The costumes remain at the theatre until after the performance. She will be responsible for collecting the costumes after each use and counting them to make sure none are lost. You will also need to police dancers so they do not eat or drink in costume.

Rehearsal and Performance Chaperones. According to the policy of the theatre, we must have one parent per ten children to serve as chaperones. You will also need to police dancers so they do not eat or drink in costume or in the theatre.

Costumes

INCLUDED IN THE PERFORMANCE FEE IS THE COST OF COSTUME RENTAL. Please do not eat or drink or allow your child to eat or drink in costume. All female dancers should wear pink tights and pink ballet slippers. Exceptions are as follows.

Caterpillar- pointe shoes painted black and black tights

Tweedle Dee and Tweedle Dum- black ballet slippers

Makeup and Hair

Stage makeup is worn to enhance facial features because the stage lights cause the dancer's features to be lost. Stage makeup should be applied more heavily than street makeup. All hair must be off the face. If the hair is long enough, please put it in a bun. The very young children do not need to put their hair up if you are unable. Please leave all jewelry, watches, and valuables at home. Bring extra bobby pins, safety pins, makeup, hair spray, needle and thread for emergencies, etc.
